Directions:

The Sheraton Inn Crossroads is reached via **Route 17 North** in Mahwah, New Jersey. Exit at Sheraton Crossroads Boulevard/ Mountainside Avenue on right. Follow signs to Crossroads Corporate Center and Hotel.

From the New York Thruway: to Exit 15, follow Route 17 South towards Mahwah, New Jersey. Exit at Crossroads Boulevard/ Mountainside Avenue on right. Follow signs to Crossroads Corporate Center and Hotel.

From the Garden State Parkway: Exit 163 to Rt. 17 North and follow the directions above.

From Morristown: Route 287 North to Exit 66 (Route 17 South/ Mahwah) Take first exit on right. Follow signs to Hotel.

Good Samaritan Hospital, Suffern, New York, is a non-profit, 370-bed hospital providing emergency, medical, surgical, obstetrical/ gynecological and acute care services to residents of Rockland and Southern Orange Counties in New York; and northern Bergen County, New Jersey. The hospital also serves these communities as an area Level II Trauma Center. In October, 2003, Good Samaritan Hospital began offering primary angioplasty and was approved by the State for a full cardiac surgery program in March of 2005.

Good Samaritan Hospital was approved by the State as a regional Stroke Center in August of 2005, also earning Certification by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations. Good Samaritan provides regional specialty services, including comprehensive cancer treatment services; cardiac care programs which include an active cardiac catheterization laboratory; electrophysiology studies; maternal/ child services, including a high level II special care nursery.
