N.Y. firefighter/EMT dies of heart attack

Duty Death: Edward Mueller - [West Islip, New York]

WEST ISLIP, N.Y. — An EMT and member of the West Islip Fire Department suffered a fatal heart attack, FirefighterCloseCalls.com has reported.

Edward Mueller, 49, responded to a call over the weekend. He had a heart attack less than 24 hours later, meaning his death is considered duty-related according to Hometown Heroes guidelines.

Mueller was named his department's top responder for 2007. Memorial and funeral services will be held in West Islip this Thursday and Friday.
