

Pediatric Education for Prehospital Professionals (PEPP)
Combined Provider Course

2 Consecutive Sundays, October 12 and 19, 2008, 08:00 hrs-1600 hrs

Pediatric Education for the Prehospital Professional (PEPP) represents a comprehensive source of prehospital medical information for the emergency care of infants and children. PEPP is designed to give prehospital professionals the education, skills, and confidence they need to effectively treat pediatric patients. Developed by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), PEPP specifically teaches prehospital professionals how to better assess and manage ill or injured children.

Who can benefit from PEPP?

This exciting program is the first of its kind designed specifically for First Responders, EMTs and Paramedics. This is a sixteen (16) hour combination course for all levels of responders.

PEPP Students will learn through:

- **Case-Based Lectures** cover the most important points that need to be emphasized. The lectures cover Child Development; Respiratory, Cardiovascular and Medical Emergencies; Toxic Exposures; Trauma; Child Maltreatment; and other relevant information for the emergency care of infants and children.
- **Live Action Video** containing real-life footage from the field, emergency departments and operating rooms showing step-by-step for assessing and treating pediatric patients. These video clips illustrate skills covered in the PEPP Course.
- **Hands-on Skill Stations** give the students an opportunity to handle equipment and practice skills under direct supervision. Each skill is demonstrated in the Live Action Video and explained in the manual.
- **Small Group Scenarios** in which providers apply information from all aspects of the PEPP Course.

Pre-requisites:

There are no specific pre-requisites required for this course. However, seating is limited to twenty (24) participants.
