

## Man accused of punching ambulance worker in Bronxville

BRONXVILLE — A 63-year-old Mount Vernon man punched an ambulance worker in her eye during a trip to Lawrence Hospital in Bronxville, police said.

It was not known what prompted Ralph Bellamy to attack the employee of Trans Care ambulance service at about 5:40 p.m. Tuesday.

The EMS worker was working in an ambulance that picked up Bellamy in Mount Vernon and transported him to the hospital, Bronxville Lt. Richard Bunyon said.

The woman suffered a black eye.

Bellamy is charged with second-degree assault, a felony.

He was arraigned Wednesday in Bronxville Village Court. He is being held in the Westchester County jail on \$10,000 bail. He is due back in court Sept. 15.
